PRESENTATION OF THE 2013 BUDGET PROPOSAL FOR THE NIGER DELTA DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION (NDDC)

Pursuant to Section 18 (1) of the Niger-Delta Development Commission (Establishment, etc.) Act of 2000, I wish to submit the 2013 estimate of the expenditure of the Commission for the kind consideration and approval of the National Assembly.

The Commission has submitted a Budget Proposal of ₦315,805,990,000.00 (three hundred and fifteen billion, eight hundred and five million, nine hundred and ninety thousand Naira) only for 2013, as against ₦250,857,930,000.00 (two hundred and fifty billion, eight hundred and fifty-seven million, nine hundred and thirty thousand Naira) only, in 2012, representing an increase of about 26%. It is noted that the Budget is a

collaborative effort of stakeholders of the region to address vital developmental challenges and is aimed at promoting economic growth, creating wealth, reducing poverty and increasing service delivery to the people of the Niger Delta Region.

The breakdown of the proposed budget is as follows:

Notes that pursuant to Order XII, Rule 94 of the House Standing Orders, Bills passed by the preceding Assembly and forwarded to the senate for concurrence for which no concurrence were made or negated, or passed by the Senate and forwarded to the House for which no concurrence were made or negated or which were passed by the National Assembly and forwarded to the President for assent but for which assent or withholding thereof was not communicated before the end of the tenure of the Assembly, the House may resolve that such Bills upon being re-gazetted or clean copy circulated be reconsidered in Committee of the Whole without being commenced *de-novo*;

Further notes that the National Automotive Design and Development Council Bill was passed by the preceding House and forwarded to the Senate for Concurrence for which no concurrence was made by the Senate before the end of the tenure of the last Assembly;
