THE SENATE.

OBSERVES the outbreak of MEASLES in the Northern parts of Nigeria as a result of excessive heat for the past two months;

NOTES as a result, 36 Kids have lost their lives so far;

NOTES also about 3,588 children aged between 9 months and 3 years are on admission in various hospitals in the Northern parts of the country;

AWARE that Zamfara, Katsina, Jigawa, Niger, Yobe, and Kano States have recorded deaths caused by this menace;

AWARE also that in Katsina State, about 1,260 children are affected, Jigawa has recorded 884 cases, while Kano State has 800 victims affected;

NOTES that Yobe, Zamfara, Nassarawa, Taraba, Kaduna and Bauchi States have reported cases of affected children;

FURTHER aware that Nigeria ranks among countries with the highest cases of measles infection in the world according to the World Health Organization;

ALSO aware that 9% of 20 million children who did not receive the first dose of vaccine against measles in 2011 were Nigerian children, and this number was 1.7 million children;

WORRIED that despite tremendous progress, one child still dies every 20 seconds from a disease that could have been prevented by an existing vaccine;
