ORDERS OF THE DAY**BILLS**

A Bill for an Act to authorize the issue from the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Federation the total sum of ₦4,642,960,000,000 (Four Trillion, Six Hundred and Forty-Two Billion, Nine Hundred and Sixty Million Naira) only, of which ₦399,687,801,891 (Three Hundred and Ninety-Nine Billion, Six Hundred and Eighty-Seven Million, Eight Hundred and One Thousand, Eight Hundred and Ninety-One Naira) only, is for Statutory Transfers, ₦712,000,000,000 (Seven Hundred and Twelve Billion Naira) only, is for Debt Service, ₦2,430,665,361,597 (Two Trillion, Four Hundred and Thirty Billion, Six Hundred and Sixty-Five Million, Three Hundred and Sixty-One Thousand, Five Hundred and Ninety-Seven Naira) only, is for Recurrent (Non-Debt) Expenditure while the balance of ₦1,100,606,836,512 (One Trillion, One Hundred Billion, Six Hundred and Six Million, Eight Hundred and Thirty-Six Thousand, Five Hundred and Twelve Naira) only, is for contribution to the Development Fund for Capital Expenditure for the year ending on the 31st day of December, 2014 (*First Allotted Day*) — *Second Reading*.
2. A Bill for an Act to Amend the Nigerian Defence Academy Act Cap. 101 Laws of the Federation of Nigeria, 2004 by providing for ways of Inculcating Civil Ideas in Military Officers and for Other Related Matters (HB. 315) — *Second Reading*.
