

A BILL FOR AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE PROTECTION OF RIGHTS ONLINE, TO PROTECT INTERNET USERS IN NIGERIA FROM INFRINGEMENT OF THEIR FUNDAMENTAL FREEDOMS AND GUARANTEE APPLICATION OF HUMAN RIGHTS FROM USERS OF DIGITAL PLATFORMS AND / OR DIGITAL MEDIA; FOR RELATED.

CLAUSE	PROVISIONS OF THE BILL	RECOMMENDATION (S) OF COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE
4.	(1) Every person shall have the right to communicate anonymously online without fear of interference with correspondences. (2) Every person shall have the right to express themselves anonymously online and shall not be compelled to adopt real name registration systems. (3) Internet Service Provider shall uphold and respect the human right of customers by supporting the exercise of anonymous speech.	4. (1) Every person may access the internet and communicate electronically using instruments, including technical systems, which protect their anonymity and prevent the collection of personal data, in particular with a view to exercising civil and political freedoms without being subject to discrimination or censorship. (2) Restriction may be imposed only when they are based on the need to safeguard a major public interest and are necessary, proportional or grounded in law and in accordance with the basic features of a democratic society. (3) in the event of violations of the dignity and Fundamental rights of any person, as well as in other cases provided for by the law, the court may require the identification of the author of a communication with a reasoned order.
