Notes that on Tuesday 1st May, 2018 Two suspected suicide bombers shattered the relative peace in Mubi and environs through a Twin bomb explosions at a Mosque within the popular second hand clothes market known as Kasuwan yan Gwanjo . Over Twenty-Seven (27) innocent people were officially confirmed death and over Fifty (50) others were hospitalised and some in critical conditions, property worth millions of Naira were also destroyed

The House is aware that the recent attacks have seriously brought back fears not only in Mubi but the entire Adamawa North Senatorial District and this will definitely affect businesses of the area especially Mubi being a commercial centre of Adamawa State.

The House further notes the prompt response by the Two Chairmen of Mubi North and South in evacuating Victims and providing immediate medical services and ambulances which

evacuated seriously injured victims to the Federal medical centre Yola.

The House also notes the action taken by the state government to take care of treatment of victims of the attack.

The House also notes and appreciates the directives given by the vice president to the National Emergency Management Agency (NEMA) to provide relief materials to victims and the visit of the Chief of Army staff to Mubi on Sunday 6th May 2018 to assess the security situation in the area.

Resolve to

- 1. Condemned this dastardly act.*
- 2. Urge the security agencies especially the Army, Airforce, Police, DSS and Immigration to beef up security in Mubi and the entire Adamawa North Senatorial Zone.*
- 3. Urge the National Emergency Management Agency (NEMA) and Presidential Committee on North East Initiative (PCNI) to as a matter of urgency provide relief materials to the affected community as Directed by the vice President.*
- 4. Urge the National Orientation Agency, Traditional Councils, Local Government Councils to intensify enlightenment campaign and synergy between the security Agencies/traditional institution in ensuring adequate security in the Senatorial Zone.*
- 5. Observe a minute silence for the response of the souls of the deceased.*
- 6. Direct committees on Army, National Emergency and Disaster Preparedness and Internally Displaced Persons,*

Refugees and Initiatives on North East to monitor
implementation of the resolutions.
