

REPORT OF AN ACT TO ESTABLISH FCT DIRECTORATE OF ROAD TRAFFIC AND MOTOR VEHICLE ADMINISTRATION SERVICE (DRTMVAS) TO BE SADDLED WITH THE RESPONSIBILITY OF ROAD TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT AND MOTOR VEHICLE ADMINISTRATION SERVICES WITHIN THE FEDERAL CAPITAL TERRITORY (FCT) AND OTHER RELATED MATTERS, 2019 (HB. 1279)

ENACTED BY THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY OF THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF NIGERIA —

PART I — ESTABLISHMENT OF THE SERVICE Establishment of the Service. 1. (1) There is established for the Federal Capital Territory a Directorate of Road Traffic and Motor Vehicle Administration Service (herein this Bill referred to as "the Service"). (2) The Service shall be a corporate body with a perpetual succession and a common seal, may sue and be sued in its corporate name and shall have its headquarters in the Federal Capital Territory, Abuja. (3) The Service shall by training, regimentation, discipline, uniform, ranks, work schedule, work shift, recognition and remuneration operate as paramilitary.	Retained	
Governing Board. 2. (1) There is established a Governing Board for the Service (in this bill referred to as 'the Board'), which shall consist of — (a) Chairman, who shall be an experienced person in road traffic management and Motor Vehicle Administration; (b) a representative of — (i) Transport Secretariat, FCTA; (ii) Department of Treasury, FCTA; (iii) FCT Inland Revenue Service; (iv) Executive Secretary, FCDA; (c) the Director of the Service is a member; (d) the Head (Legal) of the Service shall serve as the Secretary of the Board. <i>First schedule.</i> (2) The supplementary provisions contained in the schedule to this Bill	Retained	

shall have effect with respect to the proceedings of the Board and other matters.		
Tenure of Chairman of the Board. 3. (1) The Chairman of the Board, mentioned under clause 2 shall hold office for the term of three years and renewable, subject to satisfactory performance, for further term of three years and no more. (2) The members of the Board shall be paid such remunerations and allowances as the Minister may from time to time determine in line with the provision of National Incomes, Salaries and Wages Commission Act. (3) The Chairman and members of the Board, mentioned under clause 2 (1) (b) (iv) shall hold office on such terms and conditions as may be specified in their letters of appointment.	Retained	
Resignation, cessation or removal of some members of the Board. 4. (1) The members of the Board, mentioned under Clause 2 (1) (b) (i)-(iv) may resign the appointment by notice in writing addressed to the Minister. (2) A member of the Board, mentioned under Clause 2 (1) (b) (i)-(iv) may cease membership if the member — (a) dies or becomes of unsound mind; (b) becomes bankrupt; (c) is convicted of a felony or of any offence involving dishonesty; (d) is guilty of serious misconduct in relation to the office; or (e) in the case of a member holding professional qualification, if the person is disqualified or suspended from practicing the profession. (3) A member of the Board, mentioned under Clause 2 (1) (b) (i)-(iv) may be removed, at any time from office by the Minister, if the Minister is satisfied that it is not in the interest of the Service or the public that the member should continue to hold office. PART II (A) — FUNCTIONS OF THE BOARD Functions of the Board. 5. The Board shall be responsible for — (a) determining the general policy and administration of the Service; (b) preparation of annual and long term research strategic	Retained	

development plan of the Service; (c) issuing general guidelines for the operations of the Service; (d) approving projects and programmes of the Service; (e) appointment of staff from grade level 6 and above; (f) determining staff strength, its composition and how it will be used; (g) approving the regulation made by the Service; and (h) carrying out such other activities that are incidental to the attainment of its objectives under this Bill.		
PART II (B) — FUNCTIONS OF THE SERVICE Functions of the Service. 6. The Service shall be responsible for — (a) regulating road traffic management and Motor Vehicle Administration within the FCT; (b) regulating, registration, revocation, licensing and the renewal of motor vehicle documents and issuance of vehicle identification number plates within the FCT; (c) conducting roadworthiness test and issuing of road worthiness certificate to all categories of vehicles and write off non-roadworthy vehicles within the FCT; (d) conducting training and testing of drivers to ensure competence for issuance of drivers' license in FCT; (e) establishing a computer-based central vehicle registry database for the purpose of administration, enforcement and regulation of road transport system in Federal Capital Territory; (f) inspecting and investigating road traffic accident in the Federal Capital Territory in collaboration with related agencies; (g) production and administration of drivers' licence; (h) production and administration of vehicle identification number plate; (i) maintaining a database of motor parks in the FCT;	Retained

(y) preparing code of conduct for parking contractors; (z) regulate, enforce and control "on-street" and "off - street" parking in FCT; (aa) collect, collate, process and disseminate traffic information as may be required for traffic management purposes; (bb) any other matter that the Minister or the Board may from time to time assign to the Service including collection of charges, fines, levies and revenue accruable from the matters stated above as may be determined by the FCT Administration and other tax regulating Agencies of Government.		
PART III — STAFF OF THE SERVICE Director and Secretary of the Service. 7. (1) There shall be appointed for the Service, a Director by the Honourable Minister FCT, within the service, who shall possess appropriate qualification and cognate working experience in Road Traffic and Motor Vehicle Administration. (2) The Director shall be the Chief-Executive and accounting officer of the Service and shall be responsible for — (i) matters relating to day-to-day management and operations of the Service, and (ii) with the approval of the Board determine ranks for staff of the Service; (iii) be answerable to the Board and general directives of the Minister; (iv) with the recommendation of the Director and the approval of the Board, the Minister, determine nature, colour and number of uniform to be used by the Service; (v) without prejudice to the provisions of section 2 (1) of this section, the Director shall: (a) exercise general supervision and control over staff of the Service and volunteers, (b) direct the activities of staff of the Service and volunteers, (c) constitute such number of persons as he may deem fit	Retained	

as Volunteers who may offer complementary services to the Service as volunteers and shall not be entitled to any salary or allowances for their services, (d) appoint the FCT Coordinator of Volunteers and make guidelines for the operations and activities of the Volunteers, (e) manage the financial affairs of the Service, (f) deploy the human and material resources of the Service in such manner as will best ensure the accomplishment of the aims and objectives of this Bill, (g) appoint, promote and discipline staff of the Service. (3) There shall be appointed for the Service, by the Minister on the recommendation of the Director, from within the Service, a Secretary for the Service who shall qualify as a legal practitioner and was so qualified for a period of not less-than 15 years. (4) The Secretary shall be — (a) a legal adviser of the Service and Secretary of all the Committees to be established by the Board; and (b) answerable to the Director of the Service.		
Other staff of the Service. 8. (1) The staff of the Service other than those mentioned in this Bill shall be employed according to the procedure stipulated by the Board. (2) The Staff can be on permanent or temporary appointment on the terms which precludes the grant of pension and gratuity. (3) The Staff of the Service shall be uniformed as prescribed by the Service. (4) The staff of the Service who qualify as a legal practitioner, within the meaning of Legal Practitioners Act, working under legal services, shall in addition to other functions, enter appearance to prosecute or defend any matter in any court involving the Service. (5) The Staff of the Service shall bear such ranks and badges as may be assigned to them by the Management Committee in the following order: (a) Commander General of Road Traffic; (b) Deputy Commander General of Road Traffic;	Retained	

(c) Asst. Commander General of Road Traffic; (d) Commander of Road Traffic; (e) Deputy Commander of Road Traffic; (f) Asst. Commander of Road Traffic; (g) Chief Superintendent of Road Traffic; (h) Superintendent of Road Traffic; (i) Deputy Superintendent of Road Traffic; (j) Asst. Superintendent of Road Traffic I; (k) Asst. Superintendent of Road Traffic II; (l) Asst. Road Traffic Inspector I; (m) Asst. Road Traffic Inspector II; (n) Asst. Road Traffic Inspector III; (o) Road Traffic Assistant III; (p) Road Traffic Assistant II; (q) Road Traffic Assistant I. (6) The provisions of Pension Reform Act, shall apply to the Service, accordingly the staff of the Service shall benefit under the provision of the Act.		
Staff regulations. 9. (1) The Board may subject to the provision of this Bill, make staff regulation relating generally to the condition of service, such regulation may provide for the appointment, promotion, discipline and appeals for the staff of the Service. (2) The staff regulation made under sub-section (1) of this section shall not have effect until it is approved by the Board. (3) The staff of the Service shall be paid such salary and allowances as may be determined by the Board with approval of National Incomes, Salaries and Wages Commission.	Retained	
PART IV — STRUCTURE OF THE SERVICE Divisions of the Service. 10. (1) There shall be established for the Service, such number of	Retained	

Divisions as the Service may, with the approval of the Board, deem necessary. (2) Each Division shall be headed by a Deputy Director who shall be professionally qualified to hold the office appointed from within. (3) Subject to the approval of the Board, the Service may create additional, divisions and units as it may deem necessary to achieve the objective of the Service.		
Commands of the Service. 11. (1) The Service shall — (a) divide FCT into such number of Zones and Area Commands as it may, from time to time, determine for effective organization and performance of the Service; and (b) establish, in each zone, a zonal command which shall oversee the activities of the Area Commands within the Zones. (2) The Zonal command shall subject to direction and overall command of the Service, be responsible for coordinating the activities of the Area Commands in the Zone.	Retained	
Establishment of management and other committees for the service. 12. (1) There is established for the Service, a management committee comprising of all the Deputy Commander Generals and the Director (commander General) of the Service who shall be the Chairperson of the Committee. (2) The management committee shall be responsible for the general administration of the Service. (3) The Committee may create additional standing or ad-hoc committees and give them specific function(s).	Retained	
PART V — FINANCIAL PROVISIONS Establishment of fund for the Service. 13. The Service shall establish and maintain a fund which shall be paid and credited — (a) all subventions and budgetary allocation from the Federal Capital Territory; (b) all sums accruing to the Service, from time to time; (c) gifts, donations and contributions from national and	Retained	

internationals Institutions and philanthropist; and (d) fees, if any, charged by the Service for services rendered; and (e) all penalties to be paid by road traffic violators. (f) 10% of internally generated revenue (IGR) retained by the Service; (g) all monies received on behalf of the Service by way of fees, fines, levies, etc. shall be receipted and paid into the FCT treasury within 24 hours of receipt or the next working day in compliance with FG policy on Single Treasury Account and other extant circulars; (h) any money recovered from scenes of road traffic crash and incidents or recovered in any form during patrol or other enforcement activities by staff of the Service shall be paid into FCT treasury within ninety days if unclaimed by the owner or any other person having legal right to such money.		
Application and management of the Fund. 14. The Service shall manage and apply its Fund in accordance with the general guidelines made by the Management Committee, particularly on — (a) cost of payment of allowances (b) cost of administration of the Service; (c) training of personnel; (d) maintenance of any property vested in the Service.	Retained	
Annual budget of the Service. 15. The Service shall not later than 30th September each year or other date stipulated by law or policy, submit to the Federal Capital Territory Administration an estimate of income and expenditure of the Service as approved by the Board and for the next fiscal year for incorporation into the National budget.	Retained	
Quarterly report. 16. The Service shall submit to the Board quarterly report of the activities of the Service and the Board shall submit annual report of its activities to the Minister.	Retained	
Power to accept gift.	Retained	

17. The Service may accept gift and bequests upon such terms that do not compromise its capability to fulfill its functions under this Bill.		
PART VI — MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS Offences/Punishment. 18. (1) Any person who — (a) made wrong overtaking; (b) violates traffic light; (c) drives vehicle under the influence of drugs and alcohol; (d) create road hazard without adequate warning; (e) tempered with road traffic signs; (f) is on the road with a vehicle that did not conform with minimum standard of maintenance; (g) carries excess goods or projected load or passengers; (h) drives on the road without valid driving license or permit required by law; (i) drives a vehicle with expired vehicle documents; (j) is driving right hand vehicle; (k) drives vehicle in excess of speed limit; (l) fails to observe the right of way; (m) contravene the one-way lane; (n) park vehicle or carcasses of vehicle illegally on the road; (o) park vehicle on any road in such a way that it causes or is likely to cause a danger, obstruction or undue inconvenience to other road users and the manner of parking is not indicated by any signboard or markings on the road side (p) parking of vehicle within 25 meter from road crossing, near a bend, top of a hill or a humpbacked bridge; (q) parking of vehicle on a footpath, on pedestrian crossing, on carriageway with fast traffic, opposite another parked vehicle or as obstruction to other vehicle, on roads or at places or roads	Retained	

where there is continuous yellow line with or without a broken line;

(r) parking of vehicle near a bus stop, school, hospital entrance or blocking a traffic sign or entrance to premises or a fire hydrant, and on the wrong side of the road, where parking is prohibited;

(s) park or drive vehicle on pedestrian walk-way;

(t) park or drive vehicle on green verge;

(u) illegal parking and waiting;

(v) operate commercial vehicle without the necessary permit;

(w) fails to display regulation number plate;

(x) knowingly makes a fraudulent presentation to facilitate issuance of plate number or renewal of vehicle particulars;

(y) produce or cause to produce a false vehicle documents;

(z) refuse or neglect to answer any question or to produce any piece of information or document to the personnel of the Service;

(aa) violate peak hour movement restriction on articulated and heavy duty vehicles/trucks;

(bb) violate ban on riding of motorcycle in the FCT;

(cc) violate route restriction on minibuses and tricycle;

(dd) deliberate hinder or cause to hinder traffic flow;

(ee) obstruct the officers of the Service in carrying out the functions of the service under this Bill; and

(ff) any other matter which this Bill has prohibited.

(2) A construction company shall not undertake any road constructions, or any other construction that is likely to obstruct smooth flow of traffic without adequate safety caution sign to road users.

(3) Special Trade Licences.

(a) There shall be paid annually for a special trade licence by any individual, a technician, a corporate entity or a construction company who establish a mechanic workshop, spare parts shop or store, vehicle service outlets, vehicle sale shops, vehicle dismantling and recycling

centres and other vehicle related trade for the purpose of rendering services for gain and reward or maintenance of company vehicles such fee as shall be prescribed by the FCTA. (b) Such business shall be carried out in accordance with the regulations made under this Bill for such purposes and in such circumstances as may be prescribed. (c) The Service shall, as may be prescribed issue annual certification in respect of each special trade licence, and such certification shall, in such manner as may be prescribed, be displayed conspicuously at the business premises. (d) The service shall reserve the power to withdraw or deny such certification of such individual, technician or corporate entity if found to engage in activities that endanger human lives or could lead to road crashes upon which such individual, technician or corporate entity shall not qualify to engage in business in the Federal Capital Territory. (4) Any individual or body corporate that violates any of the provisions of this Bill or its regulations pursuant, commits an offence and shall be liable to pay a penalty as provided in the regulation. (5) Any person found guilty for an offence listed in the Second Schedule shall, where he fails to pay the fine, have his vehicle impounded which shall be released immediately on payment of the fine thereof. (6) Traffic offences, fines and penalties shall be as provided in the Second Schedule to this Bill.		
Procedure and limitation of suit against the Service. 19. A person who has a cause of action against the Service must — (a) give the Service three months' notice in writing, of intention to commence an action, disclosing the cause of action and serve the processes to the principal office of the Service; and (b) commence the legal action within six (6) months from the date the cause of action arose. Service of process. 20. Any document, summons, notices, process or any other thing required or authorized to be served to the Service shall be served by delivering same to the office of the Director of the Service.	Retained	
Indemnity of members, etc. 21. (1) Every member of the Board, agents or employees of the Service shall be indemnified from the Fund of the Service against any liability incurred in defending any proceeding brought against the	Retained	

persons under this Clause, in the person's capacity as member of the Board or employee of the Service.		
(2) For the purpose of official functions of members and staff of the Service, the members and the staff of the Service shall enjoy the provisions of Public Officers Protection Act.		
Acquisition of property.	Retained	
22. The Service may subject to the provisions of Land Use Act and any other applicable law, have powers to lease, rent or acquire an interest in land and other properties.		
Regulations.	Retained	
23. The Service with approval of the Board shall make regulations for — (a) road traffic management and control; (b) issuance and withdrawal of licenses and roadworthiness certificate; (c) issuance and withdrawal of vehicle number plate and other vehicle particulars; (d) prescribing fees for services to be rendered by the Service and penalty for violation of any of the provisions of the Bill and regulations; (e) use and construction of all category of motor vehicles; (f) drivers training and testing for licensing of drivers (g) miscellaneous regulations on driving; (h) motor vehicle related special trades; (i) road transport regulations; (j) parking area management plans and demarcation of legal parking lots after protecting green areas, public spaces, intersections, footpaths, cycle lanes, bus stops and crossings, and emergency vehicle lane; (k) parking space provision in shopping malls, housing estates, commercial buildings, public and private buildings; (l) variable parking fees and penalty for parking violation; (m) code of conduct and management of parking lots for Parking Contractors including Intelligent Transportation		

System (ITS) based management; (n) parking permits in residential areas; (o) earmarking areas for parking of commercial and transport vehicles; (p) impounding of abandoned and junk vehicles on road; (q) congestion management strategy; (r) issuance and withdrawals of Special Trade Licence.		
Directives by the Minister. 24. The Minister may give to the Service directives dealing with matters of general policy and administration.	Retained	
Powers of Service Officer. 25. The Director or personnel of the Service shall have power to — (a) summon or arrest, with or without warrant, an individual that violate or is likely to violate any of the provisions of this Bill pending conclusion of an investigation; (b) employ modern technology in performance and execution of provisions of this Bill; (c) confiscate vehicle documents, vehicle identification number plate and drivers' licence in enforcement of provisions of this Bill; (d) demobilize or tow away vehicles in enforcement of provisions of this Bill; (e) use minimum force in enforcement of provisions of this Bill; (f) drive impounded vehicle to impoundment site; (g) impound, tow-away and detain any vehicles which: (i) is declared to be off the road; (ii) fails to obey instructions of the Service personnel; (iii) is used in violating any of the provisions of this FCT Directorate of Road Traffic and Motor Vehicle Administration Service Bill, 2019 Bill; (iv) is suspected to have been stolen and bring same to the attention of the police, or which was parked in a manner that causes obstruction; or	Retained	

(v) the driver fails to provide sufficient vehicle documents, and bring same to the attention of the police.		
Savings and transitional provisions. 26. (1) All assets, rights, liabilities, interests, and obligations vested in the Directorate of Road Traffic Services before the commencement of this Bill, shall after commencement of this Bill be vested in the FCT Directorate of Road Traffic and Motor Vehicle Administration Service. (2) All staff of Directorate of Road Traffic Services existing before the commencement of this Bill shall after commencement of this Bill continue to be staff of FCT Directorate of Road Traffic and Motor Vehicle Administration Service in accordance with the terms of appointment. Establishment of Road Traffic Mobile Court. 27. There is established a Road Traffic Mobile Court to be presided by a Magistrate, which shall be responsible for determining matters relating to this Bill.	Retained	
Interpretation. 28. In this Bill — "Minister" means Minister responsible for Federal Capital Territory; "FCT" means Federal Capital Territory; "FCC" means Federal Capital City; "MVA" means Motor Vehicle Administration; "Vehicle" is all means of transport which is most frequently self-propelled; "Commercial Vehicle" means a vehicle which includes a motorcycle for hire, a hackney carriage, stage carriage, recovery vehicle, draw-bar trailer or articulated vehicle and any motor vehicle primarily designed for the carriage of goods and fare paying passengers. Citation. 29. This Bill is cited as FCT Directorate of Road Traffic and Motor Vehicle Administration Service Bill, 2019.	Retained

BOARD

Proceedings of the Board

1. (1) Subject to the provisions of this Bill and other applicable laws the Board may make standing orders regulating its proceedings.

(2) The Board shall meet whenever summoned by the Chairman, or if required to do so by at least 4 members of the Board and shall meet for a minimum of 4 times in a year.

(3) The Chairman shall preside over the meetings of the Board and in his absence; members of the Board shall appoint one person among themselves to act for that meeting as the Chairman.

(4) The quorum of the Board shall be formed by the Chairman or a person sitting in his place and 3 other members of the Board including the Secretary.

Committees

2. (1) The Board may appoint Committees and subcommittees to carry out, on its behalf, such functions that the Board shall do.

(2) The decision of the subcommittee appointed under paragraph 2 (1) shall have no effect until it is approved by the Committee and the Board.

Miscellaneous

3. (1) The Secretary of the Board shall be the custodian of the seal of the Board.

(2) Fixing of the common seal of the Service shall be authenticated by the signature of the Chairman of the Board or some other persons authorized to do so.

(3) Any contract or instrument, which if made or executed by a person not being a body corporate, shall not be required to be made under seal, shall be executed on behalf of the Service by the Director or any other person authorized to do so.

(4) Where the Board desires to obtain an expert opinion from a person not being a member of the Board, the Board may coopt such person for such period the Board may determine but the coopted person shall not have the right to vote or to count in forming a quorum.

(5) The validity of any proceeding of the Board or of a committee shall not be adversely affected by any vacancy in the membership of the Board or Committee or by any defect in the appointment of a member

of the Board or Committee or by reason that a person not entitled to take part in the proceedings of the Board or the Committee took part.
