EXECUTIVE COMMUNICATION

1. Confirmation of Nomination.

Sen. Ahmad Lawan (*Yobe North-Senate Leader*)

-That the Senate do consider the Request of Mr. President C-n-C on the Confirmation of the Nomination of Attahiru Garba Madami (Niger) as a replacement for Resident Electoral Commissioner representing Niger State and Barr. Festus Okoye (South-East Geo Political Zone) for Appointment as Resident Electoral Commissioner for the Independent Electoral Commission (INEC) in accordance with the provisions of Section 154(1) of the 1999 Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria (As amended).

MOTIONS

1. Referral of Climate Change Bill, 2018 and Petroleum Industry and Governance Bill, 2018.

Sponsor: Sen. Ahmad Lawan (*Yobe North-Senate Leader*).

The Senate:

Recalls that the Climate Change Bill, 2018 and Petroleum Industry and Governance Bill, 2018 were passed by the Senate and the House of Representatives and transmitted to the Clerk, National Assembly for onward transmission to the President C-in-C for Assent on 5th & 10th April, 2018 respectively;

Notes that after critical examination of the Bills, the Directorate of Legal Services of the National Assembly observed some fundamental issues which requires fresh legislative action;

Relying on order 1(b) of the Senate Standing Rule;

Accordingly resolves:

That the Bills be referred to the respective Conference Committees (Conference Committee on the Climate Change and Conference Committee on the Petroleum Industry and Governance respectively) that had earlier worked on them to consider the observations raised by the Directorate of Legal Services and report back to the Senate within one week.

2. Need to provide and distribute relief packages to victims of Flood/Rainstorm in Modibi, Sabon Gari Wayo, Shinkafi, Kukar Geza and Ambasada in Kastina Local Government Area of Kastina State.

Sponsor: Sen. Umaru I. Kurfi (*Katsina Central*)

The Senate:

Notes that on the 17th May, 2018, there was a heavy rainfall and flooding in Modibo, Sabon Garin Wayo, Shinkafi, Kukar Geza, and Ambasada in Kastina Local Government Area, Kastina State;

Further Notes that over 1,000 people lost their houses, properties and farmlands in the flood; and many animals and fifteen (15) persons were reported dead from the natural disaster;

Aware that it has been the practice of the Federal Government of Nigeria to provide relief and succor to victims of disasters such as this, hence the establishment of the National Emergency Management Agency to provide and coordinate the distribution of relief materials to affected communities;

Worried that the victims are currently living in deplorable conditions having been dislocated and dispersed into neighboring villages as a greater number of them especially victims of farmlands destruction are stranded without the means to operate in the impending farming season;

Regrets that if expedient measures are not taken, these victims whose means of livelihood have been stripped away may continue to be rendered homeless and hungry with intended threats to their health and survival in the years to come,

Accordingly resolved to:

- i. Observe one minute silence in honour of the deceased; and
- ii. Direct the National Emergency management Agency (NEMA) to provide relief to the victims in the affected areas to facilitate their relocation, resettlement and continuous survival.

3. Destruction of property in Gumel, Jigawa State: need for urgent action.

Sponsor: Senator Abdullahi A. Gumel (*Jigawa North West*)

The Senate:

Notes with concern the recent calamity suffered by several communities in Gumel Local Government Area of Jigawa State as a result of a highly destructive rainstorm resulting in the loss of property;

Alarmed that on the Sunday 27th May, 2018, about fifty-six (56) houses including residences and schools were blown away by the rainstorm at Gumel in Gumel Local Government Area of Jigawa State;

Worried that thousands of citizens, including, children and women have been rendered homeless, with students and children now out of school and are being housed in school premises and public buildings because of the mishap;

Concerned that despite the resultant humanitarian crisis caused by this natural disaster, no agency of Federal Government, including NEMA has come to the aid of the victims either by providing them with relief materials or by helping them rebuild the structures that were destroyed by the rainstorm,

Accordingly resolves to:

- i. Call on the National Emergency Management Agency (NEMA) to immediately intervene through provision of relief materials to the victims of the natural disaster and to help in the rebuilding of their homes, worship places and schools; and
- ii. Call on the Nigerian Meteorological Agency and other relevant Government Agencies to be more proactive in predicting and giving early warning signals of natural disasters so that people can be warned and precautionary measures taken to minimize the disastrous effects of such natural disasters.
