MOTIONS

1. Need to create Two (2) State Constituencies from Ushongo State Constituency of Benue State.

Sponsor: Sen. Ahmad Lawan (*Yobe North-Senate Leader*).

The Senate:

Notes that the House of Representatives deliberated on the need for the National Assembly to approve the proposal of the Independent National Electoral Commission (INEC) to create two state Constituencies from Ushongo State Constituency of Benue State on Tuesday, 21st May, 2019;

Observes that the House of Representatives approved the proposal by Independent National Electoral Commission (INEC) that the boundaries of Ushongo State Constituency be altered by creating two state constituencies;

Notes that the House of Representatives has transmitted the resolution to the Senate for concurrence;

Accordingly resolves to:

Adopt the resolutions of the House of Representatives to create two state constituencies from Ushongo State Constituency of Benue state as follows:

1. Mata State Constituency, comprising
 - i. Ikov (2);
 - ii. Mbagba (07);
 - iii. Mbagwaza (08);
 - iv. Mbayegh (10);
 - v. Uange (11); and
2. Mbagwa State Constituency, comprising
 - i. Artikyese (01);
 - ii. Lessel (03);
 - iii. Mbaaka (04);
 - iv. Mbaanyam (05);
 - v. Mbaawe (06); and
 - vi. Mbakuha (09).

2. Withholding of Assent.

Senate Leader

The Senate:

Recalls that the President C-in-C had signified the withholding of his assent on the following Bills pursuant to Section 58(4) of the Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria 1999 (as amended):

Notes that the rational for withholding the assent borders on the observation of Mr. President on some clauses in the Bills;

Aware that Mr. President's Observations are relevant to the implementation of the Bills;

Accordingly resolves to:

Rescind its earlier decision on the affected Clauses and refer same to the Committee of the Whole for consideration and passage.
