Observes that after critical examination of the Bill, the Directorate of Legal Services of the National Assembly observes some fundamental issues which require fresh legislative action on the following Clauses:- i.e.

2(3), 4(1)(2)(3), 5((1)(2)(3), 6(1)(2)(3), 7, 8, 9(1)(2)(3)(4), 10(2)(b), 19(1)(2)(4), 25(1)(2)(5), 26, 27(4), 40(1)(a), 94(1), 96(5)(7), 100(1)(2)(3), 105(4)(5)(7)(8), 165(1), 167(1), Second Schedule (4);

Aware that a Technical Committee of the Senate, House of Representatives and Directorate of Legal Services met and worked on the clauses;

Relying on order 1(b) and 53(6) of Senate Standing Order,

Accordingly resolves to:

Rescind its decision on the affected Clauses of the Bill as passed and re-commit same to the Committee of the Whole for re-consideration and passage without amendments.
