VOTES AND PROCEEDINGS

Tuesday, 30 June, 2020

- 1. The House met at 11:09 a.m. Mr Deputy Speaker read the Prayers.

Mr Deputy Speaker announced that he had examined and approved the Second Votes and Proceedings of Thursday, 11 June, 2020.

4. Announcement

- (a) Bereavement:
 - (i) Mr Deputy Speaker announced the demise of Sen. Oshinowo Sikiru Adebayo (Lagos East Senatorial District), which sad event took place on Monday, 15 June, 2020;
 - (ii) Mr Deputy Speaker read a communication from Hon. Francis Ejiroghene Waive (*Ughelli North/Ughelli South/Udo Federal Constituency*), announcing the demise of a former Member, Hon. Austin Oggaburhon (*Ughelli North/Ughelli South/Udo Federal Constituency*, 2011 2015) which occurred on Thursday, 25 June, 2020:

Hon. Garba Alhassan Ado and Hon. Ndudi Elumelu rendered prayers for the repose of their souls.

- (iii) Mr Deputy Speaker also announced the demise of the following staff of the House of Representatives:
 - (a) Baba Mohammed which occurred on Monday, 6 April, 2020;
 - (b) Suleiman Sarkin Noma, which occurred on Wednesday, 27 May, 2020; and
 - (c) Ezennia Nwanekezie which occurred on Thursday, 11 June, 2020.

A minute silence was observed in honour of the deceased.

(b) Observance of COVID-19 Protocol:

Mr Deputy Speaker urged Members to strictly observe all safety protocols put in place by the Nigeria Centre for Disease Control (NCDC) and the House of Representatives, especially the protocols relating to physical distancing and wearing of proper mask irrespective of plastic face covering, and directed the Chief Whip to enforce compliance with the sitting arrangement in the Chamber.

Mr Deputy Speaker noted the need for the House to adjourn in honour of the deceased Senator in line with the tradition of the House.
