#### A Bill

#### For

An Act to alter the provisions of the Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria 1999 to disqualify a person who was sworn-in as President or Governor to complete the term of the elected President or Governor from being elected to the same office for more than a single term; and for related matters.

Commencement.

ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria -

- Alteration of The Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, 1999 (in this Act referred to as "the 1. Constitution. Principal Act") is altered as set out in this Act.
- Altération of Section 137 of the Principal Act is altered, by inserting, after subsection (2), a new subsection section 137. "(3)" -
  - "(3) A person who was sworn-in as President to complete the term for which another person was elected as President shall not be elected to such office for more than a single term".
- Alteration of Section 182 of the Principal Act is altered, by inserting, after subsection (2), a new subsection section 182. "(3)" -

- "(3) A person who was sworn-in as Governor to complete the term for which another person was elected as Governor shall not be elected to such office for more than a single term".
- This Act may be cited as the Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, 1999 (Fourth a Citation and Federal Republic of Nigeria, 1999) Alteration, No. 16) Act, 2017. , sterriton, 20, 16: Act, 1017.
