#### 1.0 INTRODUCTION

The Senate of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, at its sitting on Thursday, 17<sup>th</sup> December, 2020 read for the second time, the Bill for an Act to Amend the Orthopaedic Hospital Management Board Act, Cap 010, Laws of the Federation and (LFN) 2004 for other Related Matters and to Provide for the Establishment of the Federal Orthopaedic Hospital Kuta Bill, 2021 (SB. 279) and referred same to the Committee on Health (Secondary and Tertiary) for further legislative action.

This Bill sponsored by Senator Musa, Mohammed Sani seeks to amend the Orthopaedic Hospitals Management Board Act Cap 010, LFN 2004 by providing for the establishment of a Federal Orthopaedic Hospital Kuta, Niger State.

## 2.0 COMMITTEE'S CONSIDERATION OF THE BILL

#### 2.1 METHODOLOGY

In carrying out this assignment, the Committee adopted the following methodology:

- i. Placed advertisements in electronic and print media calling for submission of memoranda and participation at the Public Hearing;
- ii. Conducted Public Hearing on Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> March 2021 in order to get the views and opinions of stakeholders and the general public;
- ii. Collated memoranda from the general public; and
- iii. Consulted with legal drafting experts.

Some of the participants present at the Public Hearing include –

The Federal Ministry of Health, National Universities Commission (NUC), Hon. Speaker and Members of the Niger State House of Assembly, Traditional Rulers, Emirate Council, Registrar MRTB, Nigeria Medical Association (NMA), National Association of Resident Doctors (NARD), MDCAN, National Hospital Abuja, National Assembly Clinic, Nigeria Medical Association Niger State Chapter, Representative of the Committee of Chief Medical Directors, JOHESU, University of Abuja Teaching Hospital, Federal College of Education Kontagora, Provost, College of Health Sciences, Bayero University Kano, Youth Solidarity for Good Governance, Christian Association of Nigeria (CAN), JNI, and Concerned Shiroro Youth among others.

From the information gathered, the Committee had a clause by clause consideration of the Bill and came up with the recommendations contained in this Report.

#### 3.0 OBSERVATIONS

Mr. President and Distinguished Colleagues, Nigeria's population is estimated at over 200 million, making it one of the densely populated countries in the world. The country is plagued with poverty and an exceedingly high burden of disease. Orthopaedics such as musculoskeletal disorders, spine disease,

cancers, tumours and congenital defects are suffered by many citizens without adequate care. Orthopaedics is a specialised area of medicine concerned with the musculoskeletal system responsible for many important functions including joint replacements, fractures, joint pains, sports injuries, arthritis and other injuries and conditions.

Orthopaedic Hospitals are important in improving health care in patients. By locating a Specialist hospital in Kuta, it will bring healthcare closer to residents of those densely populated urban and rural communities and by implication extending their life span.

#### 4.0 OBJECTIVES

The Federal Orthopaedic Hospital Kuta, Niger State when established will provide services such as diagnosis and treatment from traumatic events such as accidental falls, car accidents, sports injuries and other emergencies. It will also bring healthcare closer to the people at reduced costs compared to private hospitals and drastically reduce health tourism. In addition to the above advantages, it will deter patients from patronising traditional bonesetters who enjoy patronage in the absence of a specialised orthopaedic hospital. The Orthopaedic hospital will be affiliated to the University of Abuja Teaching Hospital Gwagwalada to provide specialised orthopaedic treatment and medical services.

## 5.0 RECOMMENDATIONS

After a clause by clause consideration of the Bill the Committee recommends that the amended Bill be approved as recommended.

## 6.0 CONCLUSION
