ORDERS OF THE DAY BILL

1. A Bill for an Act to Amend the Appropriation Act, 2022 in Order to Provide for Premium Motor Spirit Subsidy and make Adjustments on the Schedule; and for Related Matters (HB.1860) (*Leader*) – *Second Reading*.

CONSIDERATION OF REPORTS

2. **Committee on Finance:**
Hon. James Faleke:

“That the House do consider the Report of the Committee on Finance on the Request by the President for Revision of the 2022 Fiscal Framework and approve the recommendations therein” (*Laid: 12/4/2022*).

- (i) that the Oil price benchmark of US\$73 per barrel be approved;
- (ii) that Oil production volume of 1.600 million per day be approved;
- (iii) that Petroleum Motor Spirit (PMS) subsidy of ₦4.00 trillion be approved;
- (iv) that a cut in the provision for Federally Funded upstream projects being implemented by ₦200 billion from ₦352.80 billion be approved;
- (v) that an increase in the projection for Federal Government Independent Revenue by ₦400 billion be approved ;
- (vi) that an additional provision of ₦182.45 billion to cater for the needs of the Nigeria Police Force be approved;
- (vii) that domestic debt service provision of ₦76.13 billion, and net reductions in Statutory Transfers by ₦66.07 billion, as follows:
 - (a) that Niger Delta Development Commission (NDDC), by ₦13.46 billion from ₦102.78 billion to ₦89.32 billion;
 - (b) that North East Development Commission (NEDC), by ₦6.30 billion from ₦48.08 billion to ₦41.78 billion;
 - (c) that Universal Basic Education (UBEC), by ₦23.16 billion from ₦112.29 billion to ₦89.13 billion;
 - (d) that the Basic Health Care Fund, by ₦11.58 billion from ₦56.14 billion to ₦44.56 billion; and
 - (e) that NASENI, by ₦11.58 billion from ₦56.14 billion to ₦44.56 billion.
- (viii) that the Fiscal Deficit of ₦7.35 trillion be approved;
