MOTIONS

6. Call for Rehabilitation on Itori Bridge Along Sango–Abeoukuta Expressway, to Re-open the Damaged Section:**Hon. Ibrahim A Isiaka:****The House:**

Notes the precarious condition of Itori bridge, along Sango–Abeoukuta Expressway, which has been closed in the past fifteen (15) months, thus, subjecting motorists and commuters to traffic logjam, robbery,

incidents, kidnapping, sexual molestation and accidents on the routes as a result of the bad state of the bridge;

Worried that the expansion joints of the bridge and the bearings have worn out due to constant usage, a development which creates serious hardship and affects socio-economic activities along the corridors of the acclaimed fourth busiest road in Nigeria;

Cognizant of the need to urgently provide for concrete structures-protection and rehabilitation against the exposed reinforcement repairs to cracks, maintenance of bearings and expansion joints on the bridge;

Resolves to:

- (i) urge the Federal Ministry of Works and Housing to urgently mobilise resources for condition assessment and commence immediate rehabilitation of the failed sections of the collapsed Itori bridge, along Sango–Abeokuta expressway, Ogun State;
- (ii) also urge the Federal Ministry of Works and Housing to comply with the resolution of the House, among the Special Project Unit's (SPU) Intervention Programs;
- (iii) mandate the Committees on Works and Legislative Compliance to ensure compliance and report back within three (3) weeks for further legislative actions.

7. Need to Rescue Asa, Oju Ogun, Ibeku and Agbon Communities of Egbado North Local Government Area and Kajo, Apata and Agbariod Communities of Imeko-Afon Local Government Area of Ogun State:

Hon. Olaifa Jimoh Aremu:

The House:

Notes that Nigeria is currently faced with security challenges which have resulted in the loss of lives and destruction of the property thus, affecting the socio-economic development of communities in Egbado North/Imeko Afon Federal Constituency of Ogun State;

Also notes the recent clash between the people of Asa, Oju Ogun, Ibeku and Agbon Communities of Egbado North Local Government Area and Fulani Herdsmen where lives were lost and properties such as houses, motorcycles and other valuables were destroyed;

Further notes that on January 18, 2022, a similar clash occurred between communities of Kajola, Apata and Agberiodo in Imeko-Afon Local Government Area of Ogun State and the Fulani Herdsmen where lives were lost with properties worth millions also destroyed;

Observes that the Joint Security Forces guarding the communities between Nigeria and the Benin Republic have abandoned their primary duty of protecting lives and properties to go after smugglers, thus killing innocent and law-abiding citizens through stray bullets;

Worried that the occurring killings from stray bullets are becoming too rampant and unacceptable to the communities in Egbado North/Imeko Afon Federal Constituency;

Cognizant that if urgent steps are not taken to curtail the situation, it may lead to a war-like atmosphere that may result in further loss of lives and properties;

Resolves to:

- (i) Urge the National Emergency Management Agency (NEMA) to urgently come to the aid of the communities affected by the clashes;
- (ii) also urge the Armed Forces, Nigeria Police Force, State Security Service and other security Agencies to call their men to order and urge them to be more professional when dealing with defenseless Nigerians;
- (iii) mandate the Committee on Legislative Compliance to ensure compliance.
