## PRESENTATION AND CONSIDERATION OF REPORTS

- 1. Report of the Committee on Ethics, Privileges and Public Petitions Sen. Akinyelure, Patrick Ayo (Ondo Central)
  - -That the Senate do receive and consider the reports of the Committee on Ethics, Privileges and Public Petitions in respect of:
    - a. Petition from Chief Enyinna Onuegbu KSC, on behalf of Seventy-Three (73) Communities of Obiafu, Soku to Bonny, in Rivers State against the Nigeria Liquedfied Natural Gas Limited NLNG\_ for refusing to pay compensation for acquiring their land and loss of use of the affected land to Pipelines Right of Way (ROW) through the Communities;
    - b. Petition from Sunny Oghale Ofehe on behalf of Hope for Niger Delta Campaign, Netherlands against the Director-General, National Intelligence Agency and the Department of State Services (DSS) for alleged incessant harassment and humiliation by the Agency;

- c. Petition from Omobolanle Adejumoke Adenoye against Zenith Bank Plc for alleged unlawful dismissal and blacklisting by the Bank; and
- d. Petition from Gyang Zi, Esq. on behalf of D.D Choji against the Nigeria Customs Service (NCS) for alleged wrongful dismissal from Service.

#### MOTION

1. Urgent need to reclaim and protect Shorelines at Anyama, Twon-Brass, Odioama and Sangana communities devastated by coastal erosion in Bayelsa East Senatorial District of Bayelsa State.

Sponsor: Sen. Degi-Eremienyo, W.Biobarakuma (Bayelsa East)

The Senate:

*Notes* that coastal erosion has been a menace that is causing devastating effects and daily threatens the very existence of coastal communities in Bayelsa State;

Worried that the issue of coastal erosion has not been adequately addressed by successive administrations both at the Federal and State levels from our Nations independence till date;

Aware that several communities in Bayelsa East Senatorial District had been washed away due to neglect and lack of attention to deal with the devastation of coastal erosion;

Concerned that Anyama, Twon-Brass, Odioama and Sangana communities in Brass and Ogbia Local Government Areas in Bayelsa East Senatorial District had experienced coastal erosion to the extent of their shorelines receding from 100 to 300 meters into the communities over the years;

Further concerned that the menace has currently created serious ecological disaster and untold social and economic hardship to people of the aforementioned communities as their homes, farmlands, economic trees, vital Government establishments such as Roads, Schools, Churches, SME - cottage industries and other critical infrastructures are been washed away; and

*Notes* that in some cases even crude oil and gas facilities especially pipelines along communities' shorelines are not spared from coastal erosion thereby constituting great danger to the host communities.

Accordingly resolves to:

- i. *Urge* the Federal Ministry of Environment; Ministry of Niger Delta; Ecological Funds Office; and Niger Delta Development Commission (NDDC) to urgently evaluate the extent of damage; initiate and execute shoreline Reclamation and Protection Projects at Anyama, Odioama, Twon-Brass and Sangana communities in Bayelsa East Senatorial District; and
- ii. *Urge* NEMA to provide some relief materials to Anyama, Odioama, Twon-Brass and Sangana communities in Bayelsa State.
