MOTION

1. **Committal of Bill:**
Hon. Abubakar Hassan Fulata:
Federal Medical Centre, Billiri, Gombe State (Establishment) Bill, 2020 (HB.677)

The House:

Notes that the Federal Medical Centre, Billiri, Gombe State (Establishment) Bill, 2020 was passed by the National Assembly and transmitted to the President for assent but was not assented to with observations;

Aware that the observations raised by the Presidency require further legislative action;

Appreciates the need to recommit the Bill for reconsideration to address the observations thereof;

Resolves to:

Rescind its decision on the Bill and Commit same to the Committee of the Whole for reconsideration.
