Based on the observations and the Exigencies of the Federal Government current Fiscal situation, the Committees Recommends the following:

- (i) the approval of the requested restructuring of the ₦1 trillion additional Ways and Means advances for implementation of the 2022 Supplementary Appropriations Act as passed by the National Assembly;
- (ii) further engagement with the executive by the Joint Committee to allow for a thorough and detailed work and submissions on the larger part of the Advances which amounts to ₦22,719,703,774,306.90. (twenty-two trillion, seven hundred and nineteen billion, seven hundred and three million, seven hundred and seventy-four thousand, three hundred and six naira, ninety kobo) only.
