**ORDERS OF THE DAY**

**MOTION FOR RE-COMMITAL OF BILLS**

1. Re-Committal of Bills to the Committee of the Whole.

*The Senate:*

*Recalls* that the following Bills were passed by the Senate and the House of Representatives and were transmitted to the Clerk of the National Assembly for onward transmission to the President C-in-C for Assent;

The Bills are:

1. Federal College of Agriculture (Technical) Ogboinbiri, Bayelsa State (Establishment) Bill, 2023; and
2. Arbitration and Mediation Bill, 2023;

*Observes* that some fundamental issues which require fresh legislative action by both Chambers of the National Assembly emerged after a critical analysis of the Bills by the Legal Department;

*Aware that a Technical Committee of the Senate and House of Representatives and Directorate of Legal Services met and worked on the Bills;*

*Relying on order 1(b) and order 52(6) of Senate Standing Order, 2022 as amended.*

*Accordingly resolves to:*

*Rescind its decision on the Bills as passed and re-commit same to the Committee of the Whole for re-consideration and passage.*

#### MOTION

1. Motion on the National Park (declaration) Order, 2022.

Sponsor: Sen. Gobir, Ibrahim Abdullahi (*Sokoto East-Senate Leader*).

*The Senate:*

*Recall that by an Executive Communication to the Senate dated 16<sup>th</sup> November, 2022, President Muhammadu Buhari had written requesting the concurrence of the Senate of the Federal Republic of Nigeria to the above National Park (Declaration) Order, 2022, in consonance with Section 18 of the National Park Service Act, LFN 2004 (As amended);*

*Aware that the National Park (declaration) Order seeks to establish ten (10) additional National Parks consequent upon due feasibility studies and Environmental Impact Assessment in 12 selected Forests and Game Reserves in various States of the Federation as follows;*

1. Alawa National Park, Niger State;
2. Apoi National Park, Bayelsa State;
3. Edumenun National Park, Bayelsa State;
4. Galgore National Park, Kano State,
5. Hadejia Wetland National Park, Jigawa State;
6. Kempe National Park, Kwara State;
7. Kogo National Park, Katsina State;
8. Marhi National Park, Nassarawa State;
9. Oba Hill National Park, Osun State; and
10. Pandam National Park, Plateau State;

*Convinced that these additional Parks are necessary for the regulation of the use of Nigeria's unique ecosystem, particularly the fauna and the flora, address the fast rate of disappearance and degradation of Nigeria's forest, and to achieve and develop adequate tourism infrastructure in line with international best practices, and to protect and preserve the biodiversity and natural heritage of Nigeria; and*

*Concludes that Section 18 of the National Park Service Act LFN 2004 (As Amended) provides for the concurrent of the National Assembly in this regard,*

*Accordingly resolves to:*

*Consider and approve the request of Mr. President C - in - C on the National Park (Declaration) Order, 2022 in accordance with Section 18 of the National Park Service Act.*
