## PRESENTATION OF REPORTS

**Hon. Zakariyau M. Galadima:**  
“That the House do receive the Report of the Committees on Inter-Parliamentary Relations, Foreign Affairs and ECOWAS Parliament to Appraise the benefit and Contributions of ECOWAS towards the Socio – ECOWAS towards the Socio-Economic Development of Nigerian in the last ten (10) years with a view to determining the justification of the Country’s Financial Contributions to the Sub-regional Organisation”.

A Bill for an Act to amend the Public Procurement Act, 2007 to provide for the inclusion of the Nigerian Institute of Architects in the Membership of the National Council on Procurement, Payment of 30% Mobilization fee to Contractors as well as Project Consultants, Promotion of Local Content in Procurement solicitation and for Related Matters (HB. 2239) (*Senate*) – *Second Reading*.

## MOTION

2. **Appointment of Special Advisers to the President, Federal Republic of Nigeria:**  
**Hon. Alhassan Ado Dogowa:**

**The House:**

*Notes* that pursuant to the provision of Section 151 of the Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, 1999 (amended), the President Federal Republic of Nigeria has power to appoint Special Advisers to assist him in the performance of his functions;

*Further notes* that the President in his message of 2 June, 2023 to the House of Representatives has requested the House for approval to appoint twenty (20) Special Advisers;

*Aware* that Section 15 (2) of the Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, empowers the National Assembly to prescribe by law or resolution the number of such Advisers and their remuneration and allowances;

*Further aware* that the Certain Political, Public and Judicial *Office Holders* (Salaries and Allowances, etc) (Amendment) Act 2008 Section 2, Part 1 (A) prescribed the remuneration and allowances of such Special Advisers;

*Resolves to:*

- (i) Approve the request of the President of the Federal Republic of Nigeria in line with provisions of the Constitution, Federal Republic of Nigeria, 1999 and other extant laws;
- (ii) Transmit to the Senate Federal Republic of Nigeria for concurrence.
