A BILL FOR AN ACT TO REPEAL THE FEDERAL COLLEGE OF DENTAL TECHNOLOGY AND THERAPY (ESTABLISHMENT) ACT, No. 8, 2017 and Enact the Federal University of Dental TECHNOLOGY AND THERAPY, ENUGU ACT, TO MAKE COMPREHENSIVE PROVISIONS FOR MANAGEMENT AND ADMINISTRATION OF THE UNIVERSITY; AND FOR RELATED MATTERS (Hb. 1604)

PART I — ESTABLISHMENT, CONSTITUTION AND FUNCTIONS OF FEDERAL UNIVERSITY OF DENTAL TECHNOLOGY AND THERAPY, ENUGU

Clause 1: Establishment of Federal University of Dental Technology and Therapy, Enugu. Clause 1: Dedoral University of Dental Technology and

- (1) There is established the Federal University of Dental Technology and Therapy, Enugu (in this Bill referred to as "the University").
- (2) The University
 - (a) shall be a body corporate with perpetual succession and a common seal; and
 - (b) may sue or be sued in its corporate name (Hon. Peter Akpatason Deputy House Leader).

Question that Clause 1 stands part of the Bill - Agreed to.

Clause 2: Objects of the University.

The objects of the University are to -

- (a) encourage the advancement of learning and to hold out to all persons without distinction of race, creed, sex or political conviction the opportunity of acquiring higher and liberal education;
- develop, offer academic and professional programmes leading to the award of certificates, first degrees, post-graduate diploma and other higher degrees, which emphasises planning, adaptive, developmental and productive skills in education, technology, applied science, commerce, art, social science, humanities, management and allied professional disciplines;
- (c) encourage and promote scholarship and conduct research in restricted fields of learning and human endeavour and produce socially matured educated men and women with capability not only to understand the needs of Nigeria as a nation, but also to exploit existing educational infrastructures and improve on them to develop new ones;
- (d) relate its activities to the social, cultural and economic needs of the people of Nigeria; and
- (e) undertake other activities appropriate for a university of the highest standard (Hon. Peter Akpatason Deputy House Leader).

Clause 3: Membership of the University.

- demand and receive from any student or any other person attending the University for the purpose of instruction such fees as the University may determine, subject to the overall directives of the appropriate authority;
- (h) subject to section 21 of this Bill, to acquire, hold, grant, charge or otherwise deal with or dispose of movable and immovable property wherever situate;
- (i) accept gifts, legacies and donations, but without obligation to accept the same for a particular purpose unless it approves the terms and conditions attaching to them;
- (j) enter into contracts, establish trusts, act as trustee, solely or jointly with any other person, employ and act through agents;
- (k) erect, provide, equip and maintain libraries, laboratories, lecture halls, halls of residence, refectories, sports grounds, playing fields and other buildings or things necessary, suitable or convenient for any of the objects of the University;
- (l) hold public lectures and undertake printing, publishing and book selling;
- subject to any limitation or condition imposed by statute, to invest any money appertaining to the University by way of endowment, whether for general or special purposes, and such other money as may not be immediately required for current expenditure, in any investment or security or in the purchase or improvement of land, with power to vary any such investment and to deposit any money for the time being un-invested with any bank on deposit or current account;
- of any or all of the property movable or immovable of the University, such money as the Council may in its discretion, find necessary or expedient to borrow or to guarantee any loan, advance or credit facility;
- (o) make gifts for any charitable purpose;
- (p) do anything which it is authorised or required by this Bill or by any other Statute to do; and
- (q) do all such acts or things, whether or not incidental to the powers, as may advance the objects of the University.
- (2) Subject to the provisions of this Bill and of the Statutes made under it and without prejudice to section 9 (2) of this Bill, the powers conferred on the

University by subsection (1) shall be exercisable on behalf of the University by the Council or by the Senate or in any other manner which may be authorised by this Bill (Hon. Peter Akpatason — Deputy House Leader).

Question that Clause 4 stands part of the Bill - Agreed to.

Clause 5: Chancellor to take precedence before other members.

- (1) The Chancellor shall in relation to the University, take precedence before all other members of the University, and when he is present shall preside at all meetings of Convocation held for conferring degrees.
- The Pro-Chancellor shall, in relation to the University, take precedence before all other members of the University except the Chancellor, and except for the Vice-Chancellor when acting as Chairman of Congregation or Convocation, and the Pro-Chancellor shall, when he is present, be the Chairman at all meetings of the Council (Hon. Peter Akpatason Deputy House Leader).

Question that Clause 5 stands part of the Bill - Agreed to.

Clause 6: Composition of the Council of the University.

- (1) The Council of the University shall consist of
 - (a) the Pro-Chancellor;
 - (b) the Vice-Chancellor;
 - (c) the Deputy Vice-Chancellors;
 - (d) one person from the Federal Ministry responsible for education;
 - (e) six persons representing a variety of interests and broadly representative of the whole Federation to be appointed by the President;
 - (f) four persons appointed by the Senate from among its members;
 - (g) two persons appointed by the Congregation from among its members; and
 - (h) one person appointed by Convocation from among its members.
- (2) Persons to be appointed to the Council shall be persons of proven integrity, knowledgeable and familiar with the affairs and tradition of the University (*Hon. Peter Akpatason Deputy House Leader*).

Question that Clause 6 stands part of the Bill - Agreed to.

Clause 7: Functions of the Council and its Finance and General Purposes Committee.

- Subject to the provisions of this Bill relating to the Visitor, the Council shall be the governing body of the University and shall be charged with the general control and superintendence of the policy, finances and property of the University, including its public relations.
- (2) There shall be the Finance and General Purposes Committee of the Council, which shall, subject to the directions of the Council, exercise control over

the property and expenditure of the Council as the Council may delegate to it.

- Provision shall be made by Statute with respect to the constitution of the Finance and General Purposes Committee. (3)
- The Council shall ensure proper accounts of the University are kept and that the accounts of the University are audited annually by auditors appointed by the Council from the list and in accordance with guidelines supplied by the (4) Auditor-General for the Federation, and that an annual report is published by the University together with certified copies of the accounts as audited.
- Subject to this Bill and the Statutes, the Council and the Finance and General Purposes Committee may each make rules for the purpose of exercising any of their respective functions or of regulating their own procedure. (5)
- Rules made under subsection (5) by the Finance and General Purposes Let unless approved by the Council, and where any rule so made by the Conflicts with any direction given (6) by the Council (whether before or after the coming into effect of the rules in question), the direction of the Council shall prevail.
- There shall be paid to the members of the Council. the Finance and General Purposes Committee and of any other committee set up by the Council, travelling allowances and other reasonable expenses, at such rates as may be (7) fixed by extant government circulars.
- The Council shall meet as and when necessary for the performance of its functions under this Bill, and shall meet at least four times every year. (8)
- If required in writing by five members of the Council, the Chairman shall, within 28 days after the receipt of such request, call a meeting of the (9)Council.
- If after 28 days of the receipt or delivery to him of a request under subsection (9), the Chairman fails or neglects to call a meeting, the Registrar shall, within 14 days, cause a meeting of the Council to be convened for that (10)purpose and the request shall specify the business to be considered at the meeting and no business not so specified shall be transacted at that meeting (Hon. Peter Akpatason — Deputy House Leader).

Question that Clause 7 stands part of the Bill - Agreed to.

Clause 8:

- Subject to section 5 of the Act, subsections (3) and (4) of this section, and Functions of the Senate. the provisions of this Bill relating to the Visitor, it shall be the general function of the Senate to organise and control teaching in the University, (1)admission of students, the discipline of students and to promote research in the University.
 - Without prejudice to the generality of the provisions of subsection (1), the Senate shall make provision for the -(2)
 - establishment, organisation and control of campuses, colleges, faculties, departments, schools, institutes and other teaching and research units of the University, and the allocation of responsibility for different branches of learning;

- organisation and control of courses of study in the University and of the examinations held in conjunction with those courses, including (*b*) the appointment of examiners, both internal and external;
- award of degrees, and such other qualifications as may be prescribed, in connection with examinations conducted by the (c) University;
- making of recommendations to the Council with respect to the award to any person of an honorary fellowship, honorary degree or the title (d)of professor emeritus;
- establishment, organisation and control of halls of residence and similar institutions in the University; (*e*)
- supervision of the welfare of students in the University and the regulation of their conduct; (*f*)
- granting of fellowships, scholarships, prizes and similar awards that are within the control of the University; and (g)
- determination of what description of dress shall be academic dress for the purposes of the University, and regulating the use of (h) academic dress.
- The Senate shall not establish any new campus, college, faculty, department, school, institute or other teaching and research units of the University, any hall of residence or similar institution at the University without the approval (3)of the Council.
- Subject to this Bill and the Statutes, the Senate may -(4)
 - make regulations for the purpose of exercising any function conferred on it either by the provisions of this section or for the purpose of providing for any matter for which provision by (a) regulation is authorised or required by this Bill or by Statute; and
 - by regulation, provide that at least one of the persons appointed as examiners at each final or professional examination held in conjunction with any course of study in the University is not a (b) teacher at the University but is a teacher at the branch of learning to which the course relates in some other University of high repute.
 - Subject to a right of appeal to the Council from a decision of the Senate under this subsection, the Senate may deprive any person of any degree, diploma or other award of the University which has been conferred on him (5) if after due enquiry he is shown to have been guilty of any dishonourable or scandalous conduct in gaining admission into the University or obtaining that award (Hon. Peter Akpatason - Deputy House Leader).

Question that Clause 8 stands part of the Bill - Agreed to.

Vice-Chancellor to take precedence in the absence of Chancellor, Clause 9:

The Vice-Chancellor shall, in relation to the University, take precedence before all other members of the University except the Chancellor and, subject to section 5 of this Bill, the Pro-Chancellor and any other person for the time being acting as Chairman of the Council.
