VOTES AND PROCEEDINGS

Wednesday, 1 March, 2023

1. The House met at 11.36 a.m. Mr Deputy Speaker read the Prayers.
2. The House recited the National Pledge.
3. **Votes and Proceedings**

5. **A Bill for an Act to Provide for Establishment of Nigerian Solid Minerals' Communities Development Commission; and for Related Matters (HB. 1428) — Second Reading**
Motion made and Question proposed, "That a Bill for an Act to Provide for Establishment of Nigerian Solid Minerals' Communities Development Commission; and for Related Matters (HB. 1428) be read a Second Time" (Hon. Ossai Nicholas Ossai — Ndokwa East/Ndokwa West/Ukwuani Federal Constituency).

A BILL FOR AN ACT TO AMEND THE FEDERAL MEDICAL CENTRES ACT TO ESTABLISH FEDERAL MEDICAL CENTRE, DAURA, KASTINA STATE; AND FOR RELATED MATTERS (HB. 2145)

Clause 1: Amendment of the Federal Medical Centres Act, 2023.

The Federal Medical Centres Act, 2023 (hereinafter called "the Principal Act" is amended as set out in this Bill (Hon. Peter Akpatason — Deputy House Leader).

Question that Clause 1 stands part of the Bill — Agreed to.

Clause 2: Amendment of the Second Schedule.

The Second Schedule to the Principal Act is amended by inserting a new item "29" "Federal Medical Centre, Daura, Kastina State" (Hon. Peter Akpatason — Deputy House Leader).

Question that Clause 2 stands part of the Bill — Agreed to.

Clause 3: Citation.

This Bill may be cited as the Federal Medical Centre Act (Amendment) Bill, 2023 (Hon. Peter Akpatason — Deputy House Leader).

Question that Clause 3 stands part of the Bill — Agreed to.

Explanatory Memorandum:

This Bill seeks to amend the Federal Medical Centres Act to Establish Federal Medical Centre, Daura, Kastina State (Hon. Peter Akpatason — Deputy House Leader).

Agreed to.

Long Title:

A Bill for an Act to Amend the Federal Medical Centres Act to Establish Federal Medical Centre, Daura, Kastina State; and for Related Matters (HB.2145) (Hon. Peter Akpatason — Deputy House Leader).

Agreed to.

Chairman to report Bill.
