RE-COMMITTAL OF BILLS

1. Re-Committal of Bills to the Committee of the Whole.

The Senate:

Recalls that the following Bills were passed by the Senate and the House of Representatives and were transmitted to the Clerk of the National Assembly for onward transmission to the President C-in-C for Assent;

The Bills are:

- 1. National Examination Council (NECO) Bill, 2023;
- 2. National Drug Law Enforcement Agency (Amendment) Act, 2023;
- 3. Physically Challenged (Empowerment) Act, 2023;
- 4. Chartered Institute of Digital Forensic of Nigeria Bill, 2023;
- 5. Federal College of Education (Technical), Ako, Ago-Iwoye, Ogun State Bill, 2023;
- 6. Control of Small Arms and Light Weapons Bill, 2023;
- 7. National Assembly Library Trust Fund (Establishment) Act, 2023; and
- 8. Federal College of Education (Technical) Aghoro, Bayelsa State Bill, 2023;

Observes that some fundamental issues which require fresh legislative action by both Chambers of the National Assembly emerged after a critical analysis of the Bills by the Legal Department;

Aware that a Technical Committee of the Senate and House of Representatives and Directorate of Legal Services met and worked on the Bills;

Relying on order 1(b) and order 52(6) of Senate Standing Order, 2022 as amended.

Accordingly resolves to:

Rescind its decision on the Bills as passed and re-commit same to the Committee of the Whole for re-consideration and passage.
