1. The Need to Upgrade Muhammadu Buhari International Airport to Internationally Operated Airport

The Senate:

Notes the importance of Airport Infrastructure as a catalyst for economic growth/Foreign Direct Investment and Socio-Economic Development;

Notes also the urgent need to upgrade the Muhammadu Buhari International Airport Maiduguri to an Internationally Operated Airport in the North East with international operated equipment's like the international runways and tarmacs;

Aware that all the Six Geo-political Zones of the country except North East has International Airport (SW-Lagos; SE-Enugu; SS-Portharcourt; NW-Kano; NC-Abuja)

Also Aware that Borno is a bordering three countries namely Chad; Cameroun and Niger;

Aware that the presence of an International Airport in Maiduguri will enhance efficient and effective movement of goods and people from Nigeria and across the world and reduce excess pressure on the road and infrastructure within the Zone;

Also aware that the total land area of Maiduguri Airport can conveniently accommodate a standard International Airport;

Notes also that hosting an International Airport in Maiduguri will propel the tourist sector and provide a communication link which is vital between different groups of people involved within the region;

Cognizant of the fact that upgrading the Maiduguri Airport to an International Airport will also attract foreign investments, enhance economic development, improve the quality of life of the people of the Zone and ultimately increase the gross domestic product of Nigeria;

Accordingly resolves to:

- i. Urge the Minister responsible for Aviation to immediately begin the process of upgrading the Muhammadu Buhari International Airport for international operations; and
- ii. Mandate the Senate Committee on Aviation for a follow up and report to the Senate within eight weeks.
- 2. The Gruesome Death of Chalya Silas, an NYSC Member in Kaduna State

The Senate:

Notes with grief the gruesome murder of Chalya Grace Silas, a 24-year old NYSC Corp member on 18th October 2023;

Also aware that the tragic incident that occurred on October 18th, resulting in the brutal murder of Chalya Grace Silas, a vibrant 24-year-old National Youth Service Corps (NYSC) member;

Further notes that Chalya was an enthusiastic NYSC member from Langtang-North Local Government area of Plateau State full of Life and promise, who actively contributed to community development projects during her assignment in Kaduna state;

Aware that on October 18th Chalya whose dad is late and is the only child of her mother, was attacked and fatally stabbed by hoodlums while engaging in her regular morning jog while serving in Kaduna State;

Concerned that her untimely demise at the age of 24 underscores the security challenges faced by our nation and serves as a stack reminder of the urgent need for improved security measures and safeguard the lives and aspirations of all citizens including vulnerable individuals like the NYSC members whose safety in recent times has been threatened by various security challenges; and

Regret that her passing is a great loss to her mother, siblings, her community and the entire nation;

Accordingly resolves to:

- i. Condemn in strong terms the gruesome murder of Chalya Grace Silas;
- ii. Urge the IGP to direct Commissioner of Police Kaduna command and other relevant security agencies to immediately investigate the circumstances surrounding the brutal attack by hoodlums leading to the gruesome murder of an innocent 24 years old Nigerian with huge potentials to help build a better Nigeria;
- iii. Request Ministry of Youths to direct the Director General NYSC to appropriately support the family of the late Corp Member;
- iv. Call on the Federal Government to work relentlessly towards safeguarding the lives of its citizens; and

v. Observe a minute silence in honor of the deceased
