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MOTIONS

15. **Need for Targeted Developmental Intervention in Askira–Uba/Hawul Federal Constituency, Borno State:**

Hon. Midala Usman Balami:

The House:

Notes the growing socio-economic and infrastructural challenges in Askira–Uba/Hawul, exacerbated by insurgency, underdevelopment, and inadequate basic social amenities;

Concerned that residents are faced with development gaps, including poor road networks, limited access to portable water, inadequate healthcare and educational facilities, high unemployment, and lingering security threats;

Recognises the Federal Government's efforts through various intervention programmes;

Cognisant of the need for sustained, targeted interventions in conflict-affected communities in Askira–Uba/Hawul Federal Constituency;

Resolves to:

- (i) urge the Federal Government to prioritize critical development projects for Askira-Uba/Hawul in the 2026 budget estimates;
- (ii) also urge the Federal Ministry of Humanitarian Affairs, and Poverty Reduction, International Partners and Non–Governmental Organisations (NGOs) to support community rebuilding and development initiatives;
- (iii) mandate the North–East Development Commission (NEDC) to prioritize intervention projects in Askira-Uba/Hawul;
- (iv) also mandate the Committee on Legislative Compliance to ensure implementation.

16. **Need to Speed Up Drilling of Oil in Obi Local Government Area, Nasarawa State:**
Hon. Abubakar Sarki Dahiru:

The House:

Notes that the Nigeria National Petroleum Company Limited (NNPCL) discovered Oil in commercial quantity in Obi Local Government Area, Nasarawa State, years ago;

Aware that in 2010, NNPCL carried out several exploratory activities in Nasarawa State, confirming the presence of hydrocarbon in the State, particularly in Obi Local Government Area;

Convinced that drilling the Ebenyi well in Obi will increase Nigeria's national hydrocarbon reserve from 37 billion barrels to 50 billion barrels and boost oil production capacity to the target of three million barrels per day;

Disturbed that despite the discovery of oil in commercial quantity in Obi, the Nigeria National Petroleum Company Limited has not commenced drilling operations at the site;

Observes that the Nigeria National Petroleum Company Limited has sufficient funds, allocated under the Petroleum Industry Act, to prospect for oil anywhere in Nigeria;

Aware that drilling the Obi oil well is a statutory duty of the Nigeria National Petroleum Company Limited, as provided in the Petroleum Industry Act, which allocates 30% of funds for oil prospecting;

Concerned that the delay in drilling the Obi oil well in Nasarawa State, is affecting potential income, employment opportunities, and economic growth for both the state and the nation;

Resolves to:

- (i) urge the Group Managing Director of the Nigeria National Petroleum Company Limited to speed up the drilling of oil in Obi Local Government Area, Nasarawa State;
- (ii) mandate the Committee on Petroleum Resources (Upstream) to ensure compliance.
