ORDER OF THE DAY

MOTION

The Suspension of Senate Plenary in honour of Late Honourable Barrister Muhammad Danjuma Hassan (12th December, 1960 - 4th April, 2026).

Sponsor: Sen. Bamidele, Michael Opeyemi (*Ekiti Central-Senate Leader*).

The Senate:

Notes that the National Assembly has received with profound shock the news of the demise of the late Honourable Barrister Muhammad Danjuma Hassan, a serving Member of the House of Representatives representing Dawakin Kudu/Warawa Federal Constituency of Kano State;

Also notes that prior to his election into the House of Representatives, he served with distinction, as Director Drafting in the Directorate of Legal Services of the National Assembly, where he rendered invaluable legal and legislative services;

Further notes that late Honourable Muhammad Danjuma Hassan was a legislator and dedicated public servant who contributed significantly to legislative development and democratic governance in Nigeria;

Aware that his death has created a profound vacuum in the National Assembly and has deprived his constituents and the nation of an experienced and committed lawmaker;

Observes that the late lawmaker served the nation with honour, diligence, and unwavering commitment to democratic ideals and the rule of law;

Also observes that his passing is a great loss not only to the House of Representatives but to the entire National Assembly, Kano his home State and the Federal Republic of Nigeria; and

Further observes that it is fitting and proper for the Senate to stand in solidarity with the House of Representatives in mourning this irreparable loss.

Accordingly resolves to:
