RESCISSION

1. **Need to Rescind the Resolution on a Bill for an Act to Alter the Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, 1999 to Provide for the Establishment of State Police Services and for Related Matters and the Composition of the Conference Committee Pursuant to Order Nine, Rule 6 of the Standing Orders of the House of Representative:**
Hon. Francis E. Waive:

The House:

Notes that the Provisions of Sections 34, 35, 39, 42, 84, 89, 129, 153, 197, Alteration of Chapter VI, Part III, 214, 215, 216, Second Schedule and the Third Schedule to the Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, 1999 to provide for the Establishment of State Police Services, were voted and passed upon on Thursday, 11 June, 2026;

Also notes that on Thursday, 9 July, 2026, a Twelve-Member Conference Committee was constituted to harmonise the decisions of both Chambers on the State Police Services;

Aware that new facts have emerged regarding the provisions of the Bill, which necessitate a critical review and reconsideration of its clauses to align with national security structure;

Cognizant of the need to rescind the decision of the House on the passage of the Bill and the constitution of the Conference Committee on the Establishment of State Police Services;

Resolves to:

Rescind its resolution of 11 June, 2026, on the Establishment of State Police Services and dissolve the Twelve-Member Conference Committee constituted on 9th July, 2026.

Notes that on Thursday, 9 July 2026, the Resolution on the Need to Address the Poor Funding of Appropriated Budgets and Delayed Releases to MDAs as Revealed During the 2026 Budget Defence Session was debated and adopted;

Also notes that Resolution No. (V) of the said motion resolved to suspend the forthcoming Open Week to enable Members attend to the subject matter;

Aware that the Open Week is a vital mechanism for deepening legislative accountability and strengthening citizen's participation in the work of the National Assembly;

Cognisant of the need to rescind the resolution to allow the Open Week to commence from 14 to 16 July 2026, as invitations have already been sent to stakeholders;

Resolves to:

Rescind its decision in Resolution No. (V) of Thursday, 9 July, 2026, which suspended the forthcoming Open Week, and approve the commencement of the Open Week from 14 to 16 July, 2026, as earlier scheduled
